We are pleased to present you with the Annual Education Report (AER) which provides key information on the 2010-2011 educational progress for Olivet Middle School. The AER addresses the complex reporting information required by federal and state laws. The school's report contains information about student assessment, Adequate Yearly Progress (AYP) and teacher quality. For 2010-2011, Olivet Middle School made Adequate Yearly Progress (AYP) in English language arts and mathematics. While we are pleased to have reached this important goal, we are continuously working to improve. We appreciate the continued support of parents, staff and our community in this effort.

All students in grades four through eight attend Olivet Middle School as it is the only middle school in the Olivet Community School District. We serve 585 students in our building with approximately 120 students in each grade level. We offer band, choir, art, physical education and computer classes as well as a rigorous academic curriculum featuring reader's and writer's workshops for English language arts instruction, Everyday Mathematics in grades 4 and 5 and Connected Math Program for students in grades 6th, 7th, and 8th. The science instruction in grades 4th-6th is based on the hands on activities in the kits developed by the Battle Creek Area Math and Science Center and our social studies curriculum was designed by 4th-8th grade social science teacher-leaders from the Calhoun Intermediate School district. The curriculum for arts, technology, physical education the core academics may be accessed through the principal's office or through our district curriculum director, Mrs. Brooke Judd.

Olivet Middle School has a three year school improvement plan written collaboratively by teachers, parents, curriculum leaders and administration.

The plan is revisited each year and revised to address changes in state benchmarks, student achievement gaps and areas of concern in curricular alignment. The school improvement document addresses four curricular goals in English language arts, Science, Math and Social Studies. The plan and goals may be viewed on Olivet Community Schools web site, www.olivetschools.org

Locally, we use the Fontas and Pinnell Reading Benchmark Assessments to determine instructional reading levels, fluency rates and reading comprehension achievement in fourth and fifth grade. Guided reading groups are established using this criteria. The NWEA computer based test, Measurement of Academic Progress, is also given each spring to students in grades 4-8. Results from this test are used to place students in advanced math and science courses and to determine placement of students into intervention classes providing remediation in basic reading and math. Year-long academic intervention classes are provided for students scoring in the 1st-10th percentile in math or reading in grades 6th-8th. Extended day literacy and math courses are offered to 4th and 5th grade students falling below the state benchmarks in reading and math. These courses run from October through May.

Olivet Middle School provides multiple opportunities for individual success of students through careful monitoring of data from local, state and national assessments helping us determine individual learning needs and areas of concern. Professional learning communities for each core academic area develop common assessments and closely monitor student achievement data in the core subjects. Students are assigned to the appropriate interventions based on this data.

Olivet Middle School hosts Parent & Teacher Conferences twice each school year. At our fall conferences parental attendance for 4th and 5th grade was 97% while the 6th-8th grade teachers met with 40% of our parents. In the Spring of 2010 the 4th and 5th grade teachers met with 65% of parents and 6th-8th teachers met with 24% of parents. Teachers and administrators are available to meet with parents at any time throughout the school year and conferences are not limited to the formal fall and spring conferences.

In closing, Olivet Middle School continues to provide students with opportunities to extend their learning and to remediate where necessary to ensure the academic success of every learner. Our parents are involved and supportive of our faculty and student body as we "Strive for Success at OMS".
